

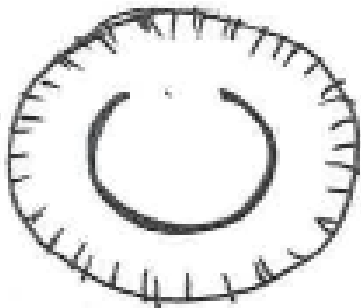
Make your own Victorian hat!



You will need:

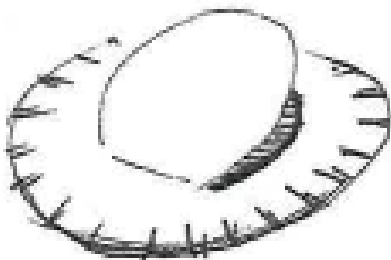
- Scissors
- A straw
- Stapler
- Ribbon
- Colouring Pencils
- A paper plate or a circle of cardboard 25cm across.
- Sticky gems, beads or any other decorations you have around the house.

1.



First off, we need to make a brim for our hat. If you have a paper plate draw a circle around the rim. If you are working with cardboard draw a circle about 6cm in from the edge.

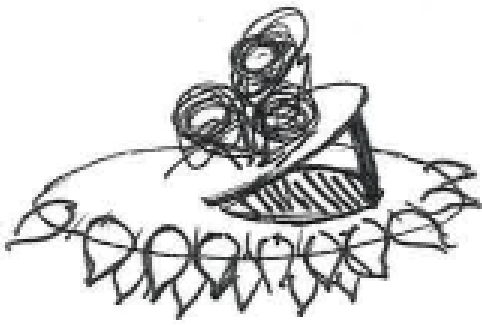
Cut around the circle leaving a small section still attached. This should make a flap, just like in the picture.

Staple one end of the straw to the top of the lifted flap and the other end to the brim of the hat.

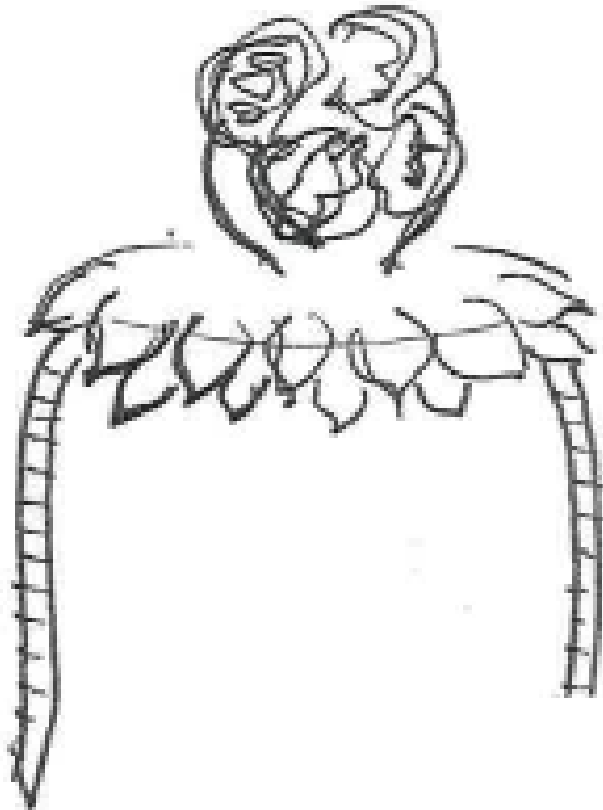

Now for the fun part! Colour and cut out the shapes on the next page and glue them to your hat. Or have a go at designing your own! See what sticky gems or beads you have around the house, or even decorate it with leaves and flowers from the garden!

Finally, staple a piece of ribbon to either side of the brim. Your hat is now ready to wear!
